

## domovari - Lacquered Surfaces

Our furniture consists of high-quality, exclusive individual pieces that are custom-made or produced in small series. Each item is handcrafted in Germany by our master carpenters. Only the finest and most carefully selected materials are used. To ensure long-lasting enjoyment of your furniture and optimal care of its valuable surfaces, please observe the following guidelines: Please do not use strong liquid cleaners or abrasive/scouring cleaning agents. Furniture polishes, waxes and solvents are also unsuitable for cleaning our furniture surfaces and will cause more harm than good. Please note that microfiber cloths vary in texture and may cause damage to the fronts. Do not use steam cleaners, as they may cause swelling and ultimately destroy the furniture. To avoid marks and stains, do not leave water or damp objects on the surfaces for extended periods. Never apply self-adhesive film or tape, as the solvent residues and plasticisers they contain may damage the lacquer finish of your furniture.

## SATIN MATT LACQUERED SURFACES

These surfaces are made from a highly compressed, melamine-resin-coated MDF board (medium-density fibreboard), 19 mm, which is primed and finished inside and out with a high-quality, durable two-component satin matt lacquer.

Remove any dirt from satin matt surfaces as quickly as possible, as cleaning agents are usually unnecessary at this stage. Use lukewarm water and a soft, lint-free cloth, chamois leather or sponge. Afterwards, dry the surfaces with a cotton cloth. Do not wipe with excessive moisture and do not allow water to remain on the surfaces for prolonged periods. This may cause staining or allow moisture to penetrate joints, leading to swelling.

If cleaning agents are necessary, use only mild products such as washing-up liquid.

Never use furniture polishes, sprays or similar products, as these almost always attack the lacquer layer and may result in patchy gloss.

## HIGH-GIOSS LACQUERED SURFACES

High-gloss lacquered surfaces consist of a highly compressed, melamine-resin-coated MDF board (medium-density fibreboard), 19 mm, which is primed and lacquered on all visible exterior sides with a high-quality, durable two-component high-gloss lacquer, then sanded and polished; the interior surfaces are finished with a matt lacquer.

High-gloss lacquered fronts offer excellent cleaning properties, as the surface is completely sealed. Adhering dirt can be removed effortlessly without significant pressure and without the need for chemical agents.

Ensure that the cloths used (preferably cotton or sponge cloths) are clean, as any mineral contaminants such as sand or dust particles may scratch the surface.

If mineral or metallic dust is picked up during cleaning, the cloth must be rinsed frequently to prevent the particles from leaving marks on the high-gloss surface.

If cleaning agents are required, use only household, water-soluble, mild cleaners.

Do not use aggressive or abrasive cleaning agents, and do not use steam cleaners.

Never use furniture polishes, sprays or similar products, as these almost always attack the lacquer layer and may lead to patchy gloss.

For stubborn dirt (aged grease residues, shoe polish, felt-tip pen, etc.), glass cleaner may be used. Please test the cleaning agent on an inconspicuous area first.

Microscopic signs of use may occur on high-gloss lacquered surfaces over time. Depending on colour and lighting, these may be more or less visible. They do not reduce the functional value of the furniture and – as with all high-gloss surfaces on cars, glass or other furniture – cannot be completely avoided in the long term. Such usage traces do not constitute grounds for complaint.
